Our Purpose

To be a biblical family of God, experiencing and expressing the love of God. The Great Commandment and the Great Commission are the foundation of who we are and what we do.

The Great Commandment: Jesus replied, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it, "Love your neighbor as yourself." (Matthew 22:37-39)

The Great Commission: "All authority in heaven and earth has been given to Me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the end of the age." (Matthew 28:18-20)

Our Priorities

- **Worshipping** To glorify God through lives of corporate and individual praise (Hebrews 13:15)
- **Teaching** To proclaim the Bible as the Word of God and ultimate authority (2 Timothy 3:16)
- **Praying** To trust God for everything concerning life and godliness (Philippians 4:6)

- **Equipping** To build up God's people in biblical understanding, ministry skills and godly character (Ephesians 4:12)

- **Fellowshipping** To grow spiritually in the context of relationships (Hebrews 10:24-25)

WHAT WE BELIEVE

The Bible

The Bible, made up of 66 books in the Old and New Testaments, is God's perfect and complete Word. It is without error and inspired by God (2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:20-21). It is the final authority for all matters of faith and life (Psalm 19:7-11; Hebrews 4:12).

God

There is only one true God, who exists eternally in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Deuteronomy 6:4; Matthew 28:19; 2 Corinthians 13:14).

God the Father

The Father is the Creator and sovereign ruler of all (Genesis 1:1; Psalm 103:19). He is a loving Father to those who believe in Him (John 1:12; Romans 8:14-17).

God the Son (Jesus Christ)

Jesus is fully God and fully man (John 1:1,14; Colossians 2:9). He was born of a virgin (Matthew 1:23), lived a sinless life, died for our sins, and rose again (1 Peter 2:24; Matthew 28:6). He is now in heaven, interceding for believers, and will return to judge the world (Romans 8:34; 2 Corinthians 5:10).

God the Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit convicts the world of sin, dwells in believers, and transforms them into the image of Christ (John 16:8; Romans 8:9; 2 Corinthians 3:18). He gives spiritual gifts to equip the church (1 Corinthians 12:4-11; Ephesians 4:11-12).

Man

Man was created in God's image (Genesis 1:26-27) but fell into sin, resulting in spiritual death and separation from God (Romans 3:23, 5:12). All people need salvation through Christ.

Salvation

Salvation is a free gift from God, given by grace through faith in Jesus (Ephesians 2:8-9). It is only through Christ's sacrifice that we are forgiven (Romans 5:8-9). Good works show our faith but do not earn salvation (James 2:18; Titus 3:5).

Security of the Believer

Those who trust in Christ have eternal life and cannot lose their salvation (John 10:27-30; Romans 8:38-39). The Holy Spirit guarantees our redemption (Ephesians 1:13-14).

The Church

The church is made up of all true believers (1 Corinthians 12:12-13). The local church gathers for worship, teaching, fellowship, and spreading the gospel (Acts 2:42; Matthew 28:19). Jesus is the Head of the church (Ephesians 1:22-23).

Ordinances

Baptism and the Lord's Supper are symbols of our faith and obedience to God (Matthew 28:19; 1 Corinthians 11:23-26). They do not bring salvation but reflect our commitment to Christ.

Future Events

Jesus will return (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18). Believers will live forever with God, while unbelievers will face eternal separation from Him (John 5:28-29; Revelation 20:11-15). God will create a new heaven and earth (Revelation 21:1).

Angels and Demons

Angels serve God and help His people (Hebrews 1:14). Satan and demons oppose God but will ultimately be defeated and judged (Revelation 20:10).

Our Church Distinctives

Bible Interpretation

We believe in the literal, historical, grammatical, contextual method of interpretation, which means the Bible is to be interpreted literally, unless there is clear reason in the context not to do so. Each text is to be interpreted in light of its near, far, and historical contexts, giving priority to the original languages, grammar, and inspired sentence structure.

Calvinism Versus Arminianism

We believe theological labels are often not helpful because there are no standard definitions. In many instances, self-proclaimed followers of John Calvin or Jacobus Arminius don't believe what Calvin or Arminius taught. Calvin and Arminius, though used by God, were fallible interpreters of the Word of God.

Expository Preaching

Expository preaching uses objective Bible study principles to extract from biblical texts what the original author meant for his original audience to understand by he wrote i.e., the interpretation of a text. The expository preacher seeks to package truth that is objectively taken from a text of Scripture and then proclaim the truth to his listeners clearly and accurately, so God can speak to His people. We believe sequential expository preaching through books of the Bible is, in general, the best approach and should be the main way of preaching. There are other kinds of preaching such as topical, that are sometimes necessary and helpful, but should not be the main source of teaching and preaching.

God's sovereignty & man's human responsibility

Scripture is clear that God determines who will be saved (Romans 8:29). Ephesians 1:4 tells us that God chose us "before the creation of the world." The Bible repeatedly describes believers as the "chosen" (Romans 8:33, 11:5; Ephesians 1:11) and the "elect" (Matthew 24:22, Romans 11:7). The fact that believers are predestined (Romans 8:29-30; Ephesians 1:5, 11) and elected for salvation (Romans 9:11, 11:28; 2 Peter 1:10) is clear. The Bible also says that we are responsible for receiving Christ as Savior. If we believe in Jesus Christ we will be saved (John 3:16; Romans 10:9-10). So while the Bible asserts both God's sovereignty and people's freedom and moral responsibility, it never attempts to reconcile the Two. We believe both to be true and both to work together to God's glory alone.

Future Events

We do not see these teaching points as faith issues, nor are they beliefs that should keep believers from worshiping together. The leadership at GBC though, holds to the teaching that:

The souls of those who have trusted in the Lord Jesus Christ for salvation will either pass immediately into His presence upon death or will meet the Lord in the air upon His bodily return to earth. Key Texts: Lk 16:19-26; 2 Cor 5:8; Phil 1:23; 1 Thes 4:13-18; 2 Thes 1:7-9; Rev 20:1-15. The church age will be followed by a seven year period of great tribulation culminated by the return of the Lord Jesus Christ to the earth with power and great glory to introduce the millennial age, to bind Satan and place him in the abyss, to lift the curse which now rests upon the whole creation, to restore Israel to her own land and to give her the realization of God's covenant promises, and to bring the whole world to the knowledge of God. Key Texts: Ezek 37:21-28; Mt 25:31-46; Rom 11:25-27; Rev 19:11-20:3.

At the conclusion of the millennial age, Satan will be released for a short time, deceive the nations, and lead a battle against the saints. God will defeat Satan and the false prophet casting them into the lake of fire along with the fallen angels. Then, Christ will resurrect and judge unbelieving souls at the Great White Throne judgment.

Jonathan, raised by missionary parents in Brazil, and Suzanne, from a pastoral family in the Pacific Northwest, embraced William Borden's motto: "No Reserves, No Retreat! No Regrets!"

From 1985-2002, they trained church leaders in Romania while pastoring in the U.S., helping establish a Bible school and Christian camp. From 2002-2014, they served English-speaking churches in Austria and have taught Bible classes at the United Nations for 17 years. In 2005, they began training church leaders in Iraq, expanding outreach as new opportunities arose.

Since 2014, they have engaged in evangelism and discipleship among refugees in Austria, leading many to faith and training leaders in Egypt and Austria. Their ministry has placed them at pivotal historical moments, including Romania's 1989 revolution, the 2015 refugee crisis, and the 2014 ISIS conflict in Iraq. Married for 40 years, they have three married children and four grandchildren.

GREAT GRACE MINISTRIES

Founded in August 2018, Great Grace Ministries (GGM) is a Christian missions organization committed to sharing the good news of Jesus Christ in Mexico and training and equipping new missionaries to spread the gospel worldwide. Rooted in both local outreach and global impact, GGM is passionate about long-term relationships, community transformation, and discipleship.

The Jarillo Family Team

In 2017, Elias and Katie Jarillo, along with their three children, moved to Elias's hometown in Central Mexico to begin full-time ministry. Their family-centered approach to missions has opened countless doors for connection, compassion, and Christ-centered transformation.

Great Grace Ministries serves in Central Mexico by sharing the Gospel, building relationships, and discipling new believers. Through teaching English and American culture classes to local children, the team creates natural opportunities to connect with families, share meals, teach biblical values, and build trust. Home visits are an essential part of the ministry, where prayer, Scripture reading, and practical support open doors for spiritual growth. In 2022, Elias became the full-time pastor, providing a church home in downtown Agua Blanca for a growing faith community. The ministry also equips short-term missionaries and is actively praying for a future ministry center to support church gatherings, youth programs, and vulnerable families in need.

MEET OUR MISSIONARIES



ALLAN AND PATRICIA MATAMORAS

From their youth, Allan and Patricia Matamoros dedicated their lives to following and serving Jesus in world missions. Allan's journey began as the executive director of FEDEMEC, the pioneering sending missionary agency from Costa Rica to the Unreached. They both serve with COMIBAM (the Latin America Missions umbrella), working with a multinational team to transform Latin America from a mission field to a mission force.

In 2004, Allan became the international director of PM-International, and Patricia became the Projects Director of the same mission. PMI is a Latin American church planting mission that focuses on the Muslim world; they have served there for 12 years. Allan has been the chairman of Vision 5:9, a global network of 180 mission agencies working to share Jesus's love and plant churches among Muslims.

Allan and Patricia have devoted their lives to evangelizing the Muslim World. They have done personal mission work in Jordan, Cyprus, and Spain. Currently, they serve in two areas of action: First, deploying Latin-American church planting teams in Islamic regions.. Secondly, from their regional center in Valencia, they are working alongside MBB Churches—Muslim Background Believers. Their focus is on Discipleship, Church Planting, and Compassion Ministries, especially in the Arab World (Middle East, North Africa) and African Muslims in the West Africa region. They actively train and equip MBB leaders, participate in church planting initiatives, and partnering in compassion and development efforts to the Muslim communities they serve.



Please pray for Allan and Patricia Matamoros as they support a house church movement across 13 countries in West Africa, including the Sahel and Sahara regions. Pray for protection and effective training for local believers, especially in areas of church planting among Muslims. Also, lift up their efforts in Spain, where they are discerning new ministry locations in cities with large Muslim populations. Their vision includes outreach through vocational training, Spanish language classes, and women's education. Finally, pray for their leadership role in an Arab-led mission movement focused on making disciples and planting churches across the Middle East and North Africa.

THE LESSO FAMILY



Abiding Faith Ministries began in the living room of the Lesso family's home in 2022, but the vision was born many years before.

In 2009, Jordy (Lasarus) met Jen during a short term mission in Papua, Indonesia. Despite different languages, cultures, and continents, God brought them together and they married in 2014. Five years later, the inspiration to establish an international Christian school began after the Lessos packed up their three young children and moved to Jordy's hometown of Kupang, Indonesia.

During the pandemic, the Lesso family traveled to the US to support this ministry idea but were unable to return to Indonesia due to travel restrictions. In the fall of 2021, Jordy returned to Indonesia on a brief trip and God opened the doors for the ministry of Solid Rock School to begin.

Jen and Jordy have been working on the ministry from the US along with Indonesian partners in Kupang. They plan to live in the US for now and support and run the ministry from here. They plan to travel periodically to Indonesia to carry out and supervise ministry activities.

Solid Rock School

Solid Rock School exists to provide a firm foundation of faith for its students. The school provides the opportunity for students to learn the foundational truths of God alongside traditional subjects. The school is bilingual which allows students to obtain English language learning which opens opportunities for their futures. Abiding Faith Ministries currently supports Solid Rock School, a Christian international school in Kupang, Indonesia.

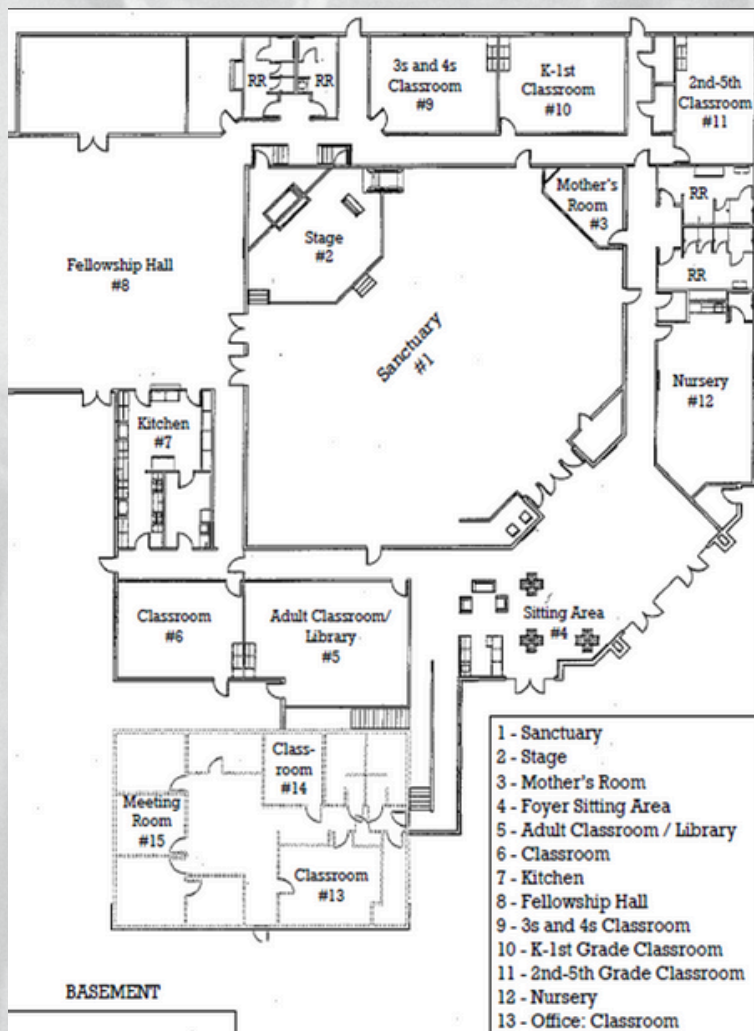
The school has classes with PreK-2nd grade for the 2024-25 school year. Each year we plan to open each successive grade.
